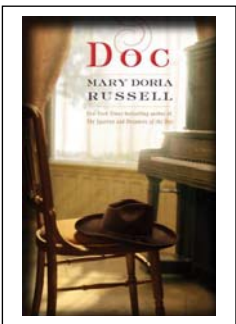

Doc is the story of Dr. John Henry Holliday, an educated, Southern gentleman, whom most of us know as the infamous Doc Holliday, the frontier gambler and friend of Wyatt Earp.

Authentic, moving, and witty, Ms. Russell's fifth novel defines these two towering figures of the American West and brings to life an extraordinary cast of historical characters, including Holliday's unforgettable companion, Kate.

Doc is currently being made into an HBO series.

Ms. Russell is a paleoanthropologist with specialties in bone biology and biomechanics, who has studied cultural anthropology at the University of Illinois, social anthropology at Northeastern University in Boston, and biological anthropology at the University of Michigan. After earning a doctorate, she taught human gross anatomy at Case Western Reserve University in the 1980s but left the academic world to write fiction, which turned out to be a good career move. Doc is her fifth novel. Ms. Russell has received nine national and international literary awards and has been a finalist for a number of others. She and her family live in Cleveland, Ohio.
